Title: FCC Approved Neustar's Permanent Routing Number Administrator Change Order Proposal #19

---

On **6/17/2011**, the FCC approved Neustar's Change Order Proposal #19 regarding implementation of the permanent Routing Number Administrator (RNA) function. There will now be a nine-month transition period during which a new Routing Number Administration System (RNAS) and a new website [www.nationalpani.com](http://www.nationalpani.com) will be developed and implemented. During transition, the RNAS inventory will be populated with non-dialable p-ANI assignment data received from the p-ANI assignors and p-ANI users. At the end of transition, assignment of non-dialable p-ANIs in all states, the District of Columbia and Puerto Rico will transition to Neustar as the permanent RNA after which no other entity currently administering or self-assigning non-dialable p-ANIs will continue to perform that function.

Below are the anticipated dates for transition to the permanent RNA:

- **October 2011:** During October, any entity that has received non-dialable p-ANIs from an existing administrator, or from another carrier, or through self-assignment, or in any other fashion, will be required to report on every non-dialable p-ANI it has received and is still utilizing, using the standard format provided by the RNA.
- **November 2011:** During November, any entity that has assigned non-dialable p-ANIs will be required to report on every non-dialable p-ANI it has assigned using the standard format provided by the RNA and also provide a list of the 9-1-1 governing authorities with which it interacts.
- **February 20, 2012:** As of this date, entities may start registering for access to the Routing Number Administrator System (RNAS).
- **March 9, 2012:** By this date, any p-ANI user will be required to report on every non-dialable p-ANI it has received after submitting the initial report, using the standard format provided by the RNA. By this date, any p-ANI assignor will be required to report on every non-dialable p-ANI it has assigned after submitting the initial report, using the standard format provided by the RNA.
- **March 12, 2012 – March 16, 2012:** During this week, there will be no activity, during which no administrator will assign any non-dialable p-ANIs as we prepare for the transition to the RNAS.
- **March 19, 2012:** As of this date, Neustar assumes the responsibility as the permanent RNA, and is also the first day the RNA will start accepting forecasts and applications in the RNAS.
- **March 19, 2012 – April 18, 2012:** During this timeframe, any entity intending to apply for non-dialable p-ANIs will be required to file an initial forecast in the RNAS, so that the RNA can promptly assess what the forecasted demand will be during the first year of implementation. This forecast may be modified, as necessary. It will also enable the RNA to make a first assessment as to the possible exhaust dates of the 211 and 511 NXXs.

We will provide additional information and reminders as we move toward these dates.
