



PAS Build Notification

Change Orders #13, #14 and #15 will be implemented in PAS on Friday, July 16th from 9 pm EST through 1 am EST Saturday, July 17th. We anticipate that there will be no downtime or interruption to PAS during this activity.

The following enhancements will be added to PAS as a result of the change orders.

Change Order #13 (INC Issue #604)

INC Issue #604 eliminates the term LERG Assignee and requires that any references to the term “LERG Assignee” be changed to the term “Code Holder”. As a result, the Code Activation PSTN reminder, and Part 1B, Part 4 PA, Part 5 forms and applicable screens will be modified in PAS.

Change Order #14 (INC Issue 656)

INC Issue #656 changes the earliest possible expedited effective date on block modifications and block disconnects from 8 business days to 9 calendar days from the date the PA processes the request. As a result, PAS will be modified to allow the user to request 9 calendar days + 7 calendar days from the date of the request as the earliest possible effective date for a block modification and a block disconnect.

Effective July 19th, when using the **Earliest Effective Date Checkbox and Expedite Treatment Options** in PAS:

- If you mark expedite only, then the PA will use the expedited effective date that you have entered. If you leave the 31 calendar day default date, then the PA will use an effective date of 9 calendar days from the date of processing.
- If you mark the checkbox for earliest effective date only and leave the default effective date, then the PA will use an effective date of 24 calendar days from the date of processing per the TBPAG.
- If you mark expedite and also mark the checkbox for earliest effective date and leave the default effective date, then the PA will use an effective date of 9 calendar days. If you enter an effective date other than the default effective date, then the PA will use the requested effective date as long as it meets requirements in the TBPAG.

Please note that the earliest possible expedited effective date for new block requests will continue to remain as 8 business days when NPAC notification is required.

Change Order #15 (INC Issue 670)

INC Issue #670 replaces the current check boxes on the Part 1 form related to “attaching Part 2 form” and “additional documentation” with text. As a result, the Part 1 form and applicable screens will be modified in PAS
